Dense infestation of weedy grasses including Chilean Needle Grass, Phalaris and Panic Veldt Grass below Reservoir escarpment.



BT Connor Reserve, Reservoir:

Dry north-facing escarpment with scattered wallaby grasses and Chilean Needle Grass recently chipped out.

Weed infestations treated, indigenous grass and herb understorey establishing.



Indigenous herbs including Matted Flax Lily and Austral Stork's Bill establishing.





Brex Crt, Reservoir:

Dry escarpment infested with colonising weed species.



BT Connor Reserve, Reservoir.

Dense blackberry infestation smothering native vegetation



Weeds controlled, indigenous species establishing including Austral Tobacco, Austral Stork's Bill and Rough Spear Grass.



Blackberry eradicated, riparian vegetation reestablishing.



Thirty-two volunteers contributed 80 hours of planting time on 16 July 2017 to plant indigenous vegetation that will help to resist weed reinvasion, provide habitat for local fauna and pollination partners for rare wildflowers.
